

NOTICE TO CLIENT

Your insurance contract may be/has been* arranged or effected wholly or partly with a foreign insurer that is not authorised by the Insurance Authority to conduct insurance business in Hong Kong. Such foreign insurers are not subject to the provisions of the Insurance Companies Ordinance (Cap.41), which establishes a system of prudential supervision of authorised insurers in Hong Kong.

It is matter for your consideration whether you should obtain further information from the insurance broker involved on matters such as:-

- a. name and address of the unauthorised foreign insurer;
- b. country of incorporation of the unauthorised foreign insurer and whether that country has a compatible system for supervision of insurers;
- c. financial standing of the unauthorised foreign insurer;
- d. which country's laws will determine disputes under contract.
